

Bi-weekly Update

Thursday, May 19, 2022



Progress to date:

As the 2022 construction season continues, the following construction activities have been accomplished during the time-frame of May 4 - May 17, 2022.

- Five girders over the eastbound I-90 lanes have been placed.
- The crane was relocated to the north bridge berm, and pre-bores and pile driving for north bridge supports have been started.
- Curb and gutter placement on the southeast side of the bridge has started.
- Pedestrian railing was installed on the east side of the existing structure.

Two-week look-ahead:

- Girder placement over the westbound lanes is planned to be complete with nighttime Interstate closures at LaCrosse Street (Exit 59).
- Asphalt will be placed in areas that have completed curb and gutter.
- Removal of existing concrete will commence on the north side of the bridge.
