

Bi-weekly Update

Thursday, June 16, 2022



Progress to date:

As the 2022 construction season continues, the following construction activities have been accomplished during the time-frame of Wednesday, June 1 - Tuesday, June 14, 2022.

- Asphalt has been placed on LaCrosse Street, south of the bridge.
- The I-90 eastbound LaCrosse Street ramp was temporarily closed, effective Thursday, June 9, 2022, for 20 working days to build grade and pave the upper portion of the eastbound ramp.
- Sidewalk, additional curb and gutter, and partial ramp approaches have been placed.



Two-week look-ahead:

- Crews will be setting forms for the north abutment wall and installing falsework for the new structure.
- Curb and gutter will be placed to form new islands and ramp edges.
- Additional asphalt will be placed in areas that have completed curb and gutter south and north of the bridge.
- Electrical conduit will be placed below grade for the new traffic signals, pedestrian signals, and street lights.
