

Temporary Lane Closures Planned for Interstate 90 at Exit 59 in Rapid City

RAPID CITY, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) says the eastbound passing lane of Interstate 90, beneath the LaCrosse Street Bridge (exit 59), will be temporarily reduced to one lane from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Thursday, Aug. 25 and Friday, Aug. 26, 2022. The westbound passing lane will be temporarily reduced to one lane from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday, Aug. 27, Monday, Aug. 29, and Tuesday, Aug. 30, 2022. The temporary closures are necessary for the construction crews to place concrete bridge barriers and to remove temporary wooden bracing beneath the bridge.

Motorists should be prepared for minor delays. Drivers are asked to be aware of construction workers and equipment and drive cautiously through the workzone.

This is the second year of the project to reconstruct the interchange on I-90 at exit 59 (North LaCrosse Street). Complete Contracting of Rapid City is the prime contractor on the \$17 million project. The overall completion date of this project is June 2023.
